Enrichment Division is designed for students who want to expand and enhance their knowledge of ballet as well as other dance forms. Although ballet training remains the core of this track, it is the goal of this division to expose dancers to a variety of dance genres, not limiting them by the strict physical requirements that classical Pointe work demands. Although they will be exposed to Pointe work, they may discover that their strength and ability as a dancer is found in other styles of dance. Many of these students will continue to dance in college or in dance ministries in the future.
